"Learning Disabilities Awareness Month" October 2023

WHEREAS: Learning Disabilities refers to a variety of disorders that affect the acquisition, retention,

WHEREAS: One in 10 people in Ontario are impacted by learning disabilities; and,

WHEREAS: The majority of students receiving special education services in Ontario schools are

identified as having a learning disability; and further,

WHEREAS: The goal of Learning Disabilities month is to raise awareness and reduce stigma to

allow individuals with LDs to get the supports they need to reach their potential; and
