4. BUSINESS ITEMS

4.1 Downtown Student Open House

J. Boyd and J. Fairley provide an update relating to the Downtown Student Open House as follows:

- The School of Music, University of Windsor will be moving to the Armouries Building in September 2017.
- The Open House will be held at the St. Clair College Media Plex in September 2017 to coincide with the opening of the School of Music.
- The venue will showcase the Media Plex and the forum for the event will consist of a round table panel (John Fairley, Master of Ceremonies) with University of Windsor and St. Clair College students. The purpose of the Open House is to “tell a story” of challenges faced by the students in the downtown core.
- The Open House will be filmed and provided to Cogeco to allow for an opportunity for the public to view the outcomes of the media panel.

In response to a question asked by the Chair regarding if the closure of the retail space in the Pelissier Street Parking Garage will affect student parking, J. Fairley responds St. Clair College students do not park in that garage. J. Boyd responds University of Windsor students may be parking in that garage.

4.2 RiverWest Windsor

In terms of the RiverWest Windsor initiative, J. Williams provides the following comments:

- Met with representatives from the Planning Department who advised Enwin Utilities installs the banners on the poles. Hardware to install the banners is required along with Enwin’s cost.
- Main focus for installation of banners is Riverside Drive, Wyandotte Street and the University of Windsor.
- There is concern it may take up to a few months to install the banners.
- “RiverWest” will be located on the top of the banner with illustrations of sculptures from the riverfront sculpture park.

The Chair offers Ward Funds to assist with this endeavour.
