## NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING REGARDING DEVELOPMENT CHARGES

Take notice that on Monday, June 18<sup>th</sup>, 2018 the Council of the City of Windsor will hold a public meeting pursuant to the *Development Charges Act, 1997*, regarding the amended development charge rates and policies to be applied within the Sandwich South Planning District. It is proposed that the enactment of an amending development charge by-law by Council would occur on a date subsequent to the public meeting.

Development Charges are levied against new development and are a primary source of funding for growth-related capital expenditures. The 2018 Amendment Development Charges Background Study for the Sandwich South Planning District relates to the provision of Roads and Related, Sanitary Sewer, Storm Sewer & Municipal Drains, and Water services.

Council is required, under the *Development Charges Act, 1997*, to hold at least one public meeting to allow the public the opportunity to review and provide comments on the 2018 Amendment Development Charges Background Study for the Sandwich South Planning District, related staff reports/presentations, and the proposed development charges by-law.

Written comments received prior to the meeting and submissions made at the public meeting will be considered by Council prior to the of new development charge by-law. All submissions received will become part of a public record.
