- 1 HACK THE FEST, HACKFORGE (WINDSOR, ON)
  - Hack the Fest in Vision Corridor with a variety of workshops & DIY tech that will inspire you to create, share & put your own temporary mark in the park! Hackforge is a presenting partner in this festival, coordinating projects from their shared space in downtown Windsor. Full schedule released Sept. 18th.
- 2 SOUND LANTERNS, NIK STEEL, DAVID BERGERON (WINDSOR/MAIDSTONE, ON) Combining game play, music creation & the use of new technologies to re-imagine a toy set of blocks.
- 3 MISHIBIJIW, JESSICA RACHEL COOK, KURT HILTON, STEVE DAIGLE (WINDSOR, ON) Great Lakes Guardian of the Anisshinaabe people re-enact the legend of the Mishibijiw (pronounced Mee-shee-PEE-shoe).
- 4 GLOW CIRQUE, VERTIKA POLE FITNESS STUDIO. (WINDSOR, ON) Futuristic aerial & acrobatic performers sore through the skyline & dance their way through waves of light & rhythm.
- 5 WINDSOR ACRO (WINDSOR, ON)
  Watch this local group combine feats of strength & flexibility as they glow in the night.
- 6 FREE VERSE IN WAVES OF RHYTHM & DANCE (WINDSOR, ON)
  Teajai Travis, Sandra Li' Belly Dance Ensemble, The Free Verse Poets & The Bloomfield House Drummer's express Windsor's contemporary landscape through spoken word, belly dancing, hand drumming & DJing.
- 7 CIRCLES OF COMMUNITY CELEBRATING DIVERSITY AND INTERCONNECTEDNESS, AYESHA DROUILLARD (WINDSOR, ON)

  Propositing the universe a model is both the microcorm of the macrocorm and we are all parts.

Representing the universe, a mandala is both the microcosm & the macrocosm, and we are all part of its intricate design. Ayesha will be using the daylight to build her creation to come alive at night, join her in Vision Corridor.

8 LIMINAL LUMINAL (DETROIT, MI)

A live audiovisual performance consisting of freely improvised music combined with interactive video projections & electronic audio. Performances are Friday & Saturday 8–10PM, inspired by the borders of Windsor & Detroit.

- 9 THE GREAT LAKES ALGAE ORGAN, JENNIFER WILLET (WINDSOR,ON)
  Transforming a street organ into a functional algae farm, towed by a bicycle, Jennifer will play music and discuss art & environmental sciences with the University of Windsor's INCUBATOR Lab + Great Lakes Institute for Environmental Research. Additional Project Sponsors Include: GLIER, The Ontario Arts Council, and SSHRC Social Science & Humanities Research Council of Canada.
- 10 DISSECTING THE PSYCHE: THE LIGHT AND DARK CORNERS OF THE MIND, JILL SNIDER (WINDSOR, ON)

Jill is a post modern artist, intersecting art & technology to illustrate the mental capacity of the mind.

11 BEACON REVISITED: FREEDOM IS A RIVER, JESSE DORSEY, JOEL HAWKINS, MEGAN HEERES, MICHAEL B. OLSZEWSKI, KIDO PIELACK (DETROIT, MI)

Beacon Revisited is a light & sound installation that is powered by the community that surrounds it. The work is an opportunity for our Canadian neighbours & friends to celebrate their history & ongoing commitment to peace & justice, & for all participants to consider the complexities around freedom for all human beings.

12 EPIC ULTRA, RYAN EYRES (WINDSOR, ON)

A large interactive dot matrix display powered by LEDs & balloons. Ryan is a local tech-enthusiast, owner of OurEvents.ca creating his first artistic project for the City.

13 FACET, NICOLAS DE COSSON (WINDSOR, ON)

Nicolas is an Integrated Media Artist currently living in Windsor where he spends most of his time practicing digital wizardry. His work focuses on animating skin-like or membrane-like projection surfaces; he is interested in the play between the physically digital & digitally.

14 MONARCH KALEIDOSCOPE (1&2). CHELSEA GREENWELL (WINDSOR, ON)

With research exploring the natural world through a digital platform, Chelsea's artistic practice questions humanities relationship with nature through themes of manipulation & homage.

15 THE LIVING WILLOW DOME EUGENIA CATROPPA (WINDSOR, ON)

Installing a living indoor-outdoor space where people can gather for a community drum circle, or simply to sit down & take a break.

- **16** THE BUTTERFLY EFFECT, JEREMY TSANG (TORONTO, ON) Glowing butterflies illuminate found objects in the Park.
- 17 PLAYART/RESOUND, QTIZAJS (KINGSVILLE, ON) As children we walked the Windsor waterfront with only our imaginations to dream of art. Now it is a reality.
- 18 TWO MASKS, ERIC BRANGET, ERIN BURLEY (WINDSOR, HAMILTON, ON) This comedic duo will tell you a tale through expressions of the body, sounds, music, & images, rather than spoken language. Eric & Erin see The Windsor Sculpture garden as a beacon for art in the city, where people can enjoy the best views of the city.
- 19 BRIDGE BEATS, GREG SAMEK (WINDSOR, ON/VANCOUVER, BC)

Greg is an internationally-accomplished percussionist defining waves of sound through the exploration of new & used materials. Tune in to this special sound structure – constructed on–site in the shape of a bridge, for all to play!

23 PROPOGATION PROJECT, PATRICIA COATES (AMHERSTBURG, ON)

Patricia is a multi-disciplinary artist working in performance, installation, video, living material (indigenous trees grown from seed), & more recently, social media.

24 OPTIC WAVES, DCREED, (HARROW, ON)

DCREED has been an artist for over 30 years, trained in many forms of art. Technique & originality are what drive the creation of each piece, devoted to entertaining the eyes of others & sharing his peculiar life story along the way. His art is created through a process of forming patterns & geometric shapes, mixed with a melting pot of colours to deceive the eye. The resulting obscurity of images & patterns create visual interference.
