The OESP provides a monthly credit to eligible customers based on household income and household size. The OESP credits are applied directly to eligible customers' bills. The LEAP is an Ontario Energy Board (OEB) program that provides assistance to those that have fallen behind in paying your electricity bill and face service disconnection
