Human waste and toilet paper are the only materials that should be flushed down the toilet.

The City of Windsor needs everyone to do their part to help maintain the sewer system to prevent costly excess repairs and maintenance and reduce the risk of basement flooding.

Did you know? The City is responsible for maintenance of over 1,700 km of sewer pipes.

How to properly dispose of wipes?

All wipes, paper towels must be placed in the garbage for disposal. Only toilet paper can be flushed in the toilet.

How to use this cup:

- 1 Pour cooled kitchen fats, oils, and grease (FOG) into this container.
- 2 Put the lid on and store in your fridge or freezer until full or ready for disposal.
- 3 Put full cups into garbage or take to Household Hazardous Waste Depot.

FOG - cooking oil, salad dressing, bacon grease, gravy, etc.

Put waste in the right place.
