

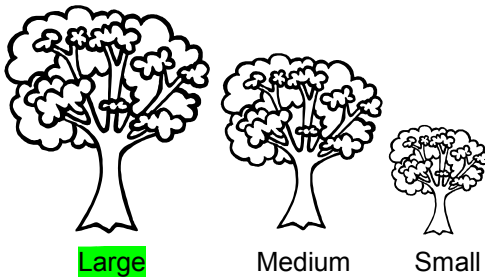
# Pin Oak

*Quercus palustris*

Hardiness Zone 5  
 Mature Height 60-75 feet  
 Mature Form Pyramidal to oval  
 Features Russet to red fall color; form  
 Insect or Diseases Anthracnose, oak wilt is a potential problem (other problems are possible, but usually not serious)  
 Culture Full sun; very tolerant of wet sites; requires acid soil  
 Notes Iron chlorosis (yellowing of the leaves) is very common on this species when planted in alkaline soils; easy to transplant due to a fibrous root system
