 City Council approval


Why are we having a public meeting?

A combination of separated bike lanes and a raised cycle track with sidewalks on both sides

RECOMMENDED BIKE LANE OPTION


Conventional Bike Lanes

(not including non-recoverable HST)



(hatching & bollards where appropriate)



 This will be determined based on approval of the project, existing conditions, pedestrian and traffic needs, cost and staging


