






3D Towers

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- A collection of 3D items from around the house (food boxes, cans, jars, paper cones, paper towel rolls, etc.)

WHAT TO DO NEXT:

1. Go with your child(ren) to collect 3D items from around the house that could be used to build something. Talk with them about why they chose the items.
2. Use your imagination to build a tower, castle, house, etc. The possibilities are endless!
3. This is a great opportunity to introduce 3D shape names to your child. Examples:
 - cube 
 - rectangular prism 
 - pyramid 
 - cone 
 - cylinder 
4. Count the number of sides/faces on each 3D shape.
