How Many Drops to Fill the Circles?

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- Paper or cardstock
- Sheet protector or Ziploc bag
- A few cups
- Food colouring
- Pipette
- Permanent marker



WHAT TO DO NEXT:

- **1.** Draw several different size circles on your paper. Place your paper in a sheet protector or Ziploc bag.
- 2. Pour some water into each cup and add a few drops of food colouring.
- **3.** Estimate how many drops of water it will take to fill each circle.
- **4.** Use the pipette to squeeze drops of water onto each circle and count the drops as you go.
- **5.** Compare how many drops of water it took to fill a large circle and a small circle.
- **6.** Have fun counting, comparing, estimating, and looking at the colours!
- 7. Keep some paper towels on hand to dry the sheet and repeat the activity.
