Paint to Music

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- Large piece of paper
- 2 or more colours of paint
- Paintbrushes
- Source of music



WHAT TO DO NEXT:

- **1.** Place a large piece of paper flat on a table or floor, or attach the paper to an easel or wall.
- 2. Choose a variety of music for your child to listen to while painting.
- **3.** This type of painting focuses on the 'process' instead of the finished product.
- **4.** There is no wrong way to paint to music. Encourage your child to move the paintbrush along to the music.
- **5.** Feel free to use different painting tools to move the paint around the paper (feathers, sponges, leaves, etc.).
