

Marshmallow March

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- Marshmallows
- Pail
- Child size shovel or large spoon
- Construction paper and/or tissue paper - yellow, orange, red, brown

WHAT TO DO NEXT:

1. Assist your child to use the construction paper and tissue paper to decorate the pail to make it look like a campfire.
2. Place the pail on the ground and have your child take 10 steps back. Count each step back.
3. Place a marshmallow on the shovel and have your child try to balance it while marching towards the 'campfire' (pail).
4. Once your child reaches the 'campfire', encourage them to drop the marshmallow into the 'campfire'.
5. Extension Activity: Try balancing marshmallows while walking backwards or hopping. Can you make it to the 'campfire' (pail) without dropping them?
