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Marshmallow March

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- Marshmallows
- Pail
- Child size shovel or large spoon
- Construction paper and/or tissue paper yellow, orange, red, brown

WHAT TO DO NEXT:

- 1. Assist your child to use the construction paper and tissue paper to decorate the pail to make it look like a campfire.
- 2. Place the pail on the ground and have your child take 10 steps back. Count each step back.
- 3. Place a marshmallow on the shovel and have your child try to balance it while marching towards the 'campfire' (pail).
- 4. Once your child reaches the 'campfire', encourage them to drop the marshmallow into the 'campfire'.
- 5. Extension Activity: Try balancing marshmallows while walking backwards or hopping. Can you make it to the 'campfire' (pail) without dropping them?
