

Moon Rock Science

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- 1 box of baking soda
- 3 cups of white vinegar
- Pitcher of water
- Food colouring
- Glitter
- Large bowl
- Spoon or eyedropper
- Plastic wrap

WHAT TO DO NEXT:

1. In a bowl, mix baking soda and a few shakes of glitter.
2. Add a few drops of food colouring to the pitcher of water.
3. Slowly add water to the baking soda, and stir, until the mixture is mouldable.
4. Use a spoon and your hands to shape the mixture into moon rocks.
5. Place each moon rock onto a piece of plastic wrap and seal tight.
6. Freeze the moon rocks for at least 30 minutes.
7. Unwrap frozen moon rocks, place them on a plate, and pour vinegar on top using a spoon or eyedropper.
8. Watch and listen to them fizz!
