

## Tie Dye Easter Egg

### WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- White hard-boiled eggs
- Paper towels
- Food colouring
- Spray bottle with water
- Twist ties or small elastic
- Glass dish or baking sheet
- Disposable glove (optional)



### WHAT TO DO NEXT:

1. Place a hard-boiled egg in the middle of a piece of paper towel.
2. Bunch up the paper towel around the egg so it is completely covered.
3. Twist the end as tight as possible, and tie it with a twist tie or elastic.
4. Hold the egg in your hand (with a disposable glove), and squeeze drops of different coloured food colouring on the paper towel.
5. Take your spray bottle, and spray the middle of each colour. Continue to spray until the paper towel is completely coloured. The more water you spray the less brightly coloured the egg will be.
6. Gently squeeze the egg over the sink to transfer the colours onto the egg. You can wear rubber gloves if you don't want to stain your hands.
7. Set the eggs in a glass dish or on a baking sheet to dry overnight.
8. Once dry, remove the egg from the paper towel.
9. Admire the beautiful colours and texture from the impression of the paper towel!
