Writing with Icicles

Bundle up and go on an outdoor adventure with your child to collect icicles.

If there are no icicles outside, you can make your own by filling the bottoms of a few Ziploc bags with water and placing them in the freezer overnight. Together with your child, hold an icicle like a pencil and use it to 'write' on coloured construction paper. You might need to take a break or wear some winter gloves if your hands get too cold. Using icicles is a new and exciting way for children to learn letters and practice writing. It is also a great sensory activity.

Melting Snow Person

Glue stick

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

- Container
- Spoon
 - Snow
- Sealable bag Scissors

WHAT TO DO:

- Use a spoon to collect some snow and place it in the container. 1. 2 With assistance, use the scissors to cut two eyes, a nose, and a
- mouth out of felt or paper. Glue the items onto the sealable bag to make a face. 3.
- 4. Place the snow into the bag and seal it tight.
- Tape the bag to a window or place it on a flat surface and 5. watch what happens!
- How long do you think it will take the snow person to melt? 6.
