### Pathway to Potential & Social Investment in Windsor-Essex

- Since 2009, Pathway to Potential (P2P) has been the City of Windsor and County of Essex response to addressing the needs of children and families living in poverty.
- In 2017, P2P became a comprehensive 9-point social investment plan, focused on essential social investments in residents, neighbourhoods and the larger community.

# What is Tax Relief?

- The tax relief application is available for those property owners who are applying for tax relief due to **extreme poverty or sickness** under Section 357. (1) (d.1) of the *Ontario Municipal Act*.
- The intention of the program is to provide temporary relief for those property owners who may qualify.
- Subject to qualification, the amount of relief would be up to the amount of taxes levied for the year applied for and any applicable interest
- Example: Home valued at \$150,000 property taxes \$2,600 Maximum amount of tax relief \$1,887.00 for 2020's taxes

Requesting Tax

Tax Rebates and Relief

Information

- Property owners who have opted to have their mortgage or financial institution remit property taxes directly to the City will receive their 2020 Final Tax Bill for information only. No action is necessary. The mortgage and financial institution will continue to receive information related to payment. A \$30 annual administrative fee will be charged to the mortgage/financial institution.
- Final tax rates have been set, which when applied to the current assessment values will result in an average increase in property tax of 2.15% or

### Tax Relief Application

#### TAX RELIEF APPLICATION – Extreme Poverty or Sickness (Municipal Act, 2001 – Section 357(1) (d.1)

The deadline for submitting applications is the last day of February of the year following the taxation year to which the application relates.

To be eligible for Tax Relief (cancellation, reduction or refund of taxes), you must satisfy the conditions which are outlined under the section of which you are applying for.

## **NINDSOR** Deadlines

- Tax Relief Application February 28, 2021
- Supporting documentation May 31, 2021
- At that point everything will be reviewed and a letter will be sent to the applicant indicating whether the Tax Department is recommending that Council should approve or deny the application.
- If the recommendation is to deny, the applicant will have 30 days from the date of the letter to file and appeal to the Property Tax Relief Internal Review Panel. The decision of the committee will be what is recommended to Council.
- Once approved by Council, the amount of tax relief will be credited to the applicant's tax account
- Council meeting is the last week of September

# Top Thing to Remember

- Submitting the Tax Relief application <u>and</u> the Financial Disclosure by February 28, 2021
- Filing your taxes by the April 30, 2021 deadline in order to get your Notice of Assessment
