## "Emancipation Day" August 1, 2024

WHEREAS:

August 1, 1834, was the date that slavery was abolished throughout the

British Colonies by King William IV pursuant to the Slavery Abolition Act

of 1833; and,

WHEREAS:

Within fifteen years of the abolition of slavery, between 35,000 and

40,000 Black settlers made their way to Ontario in large part by the

Underground Railroad into Southwestern Ontario; and,

WHEREAS:

As a demonstration of our respect for human liberty and freedom and in

recognition of the richness of the culture and history brought to Ontario

by African Canadians; and,

THEREFORE: I, Drew Dilkens, Mayor of the City of Windsor, do hereby proclaim
