"Walk to Make Cystic Fibrosis History"

WHEREAS:

Cystic Fibrosis (CF) is the most common fatal genetic disease affecting Canadian children and young adults. There is no cure. It is a multi-system disease that attacks the lungs and digestive system. There are more than 4,400 Canadians living with Cystic Fibrosis; and,

WHEREAS:

Thanks to investments in CF research and care, there is hope. Canadians are living longer, healthier lives than ever before. Today, 66 percent of Canadians with Cystic Fibrosis are adults, but of the Canadians with Cystic Fibrosis who died in the past five years, half were under the age of 37. This is far too young; and,

WHEREAS:

This year, your local Walk to Make Cystic Fibrosis History event is once again returning with both in-person and virtual options to participate. Cystic Fibrosis Canada is calling on you, the power of the community to rally with them to make it better than ever; and,

WHEREAS:

We encourage our citizens to take a #StepFoward for Canadians with Cystic Fibrosis by participating in the Walk to Make Cystic Fibrosis History. Your support will help raise critical funds needed to find a cure for Cystic Fibrosis, and to help Canadians who live with this fatal disease; and,
