Road closures on a Truck Route will detour truck traffic along truck routes 3 meter minimum lane width to be maintained. All signs and spacing per Ontario Traffic Manual (OTM) Book 7 (2022) Should site conditions require a revision to attached plan, revise and resubmit traffic control plan. DO NOT place signs in pedestrian pathways, bike lanes or motorists sight lines. 							
 Any existing signs in Right of Way that conflict are to be covered so not to damage them. Do not remove City owned signs or poles. Temporary paint is not allowed unless pre-approved. Restore to original before leaving site. Changes or corrections to Traffic Control Plans, to be compliant with reviewed plans, are at the contractor's expense.
