Parking is available near the marina at the corner of Riverside Drive and Riverdale.

Arrive at Lakeview Park Marina 15 minutes before departure. All visitors must sign a waiver and show photo ID. Minors under 18 must be with an adult.

Boat service runs from 10:00 a.m. to 1:15 p.m., with the final return trip to the marina at 2:00 p.m.


WHAT TO DO
