Dear Nawar Talia,

Soil and Materials Engineering Inc. (SME) is pleased to provide this letter as it serves to address the properties located at 3858 - 3868 Peter Street, Windsor, Ontario, hereinafter referred to as the "site", and potential impacts from waste disposal sites located within a 500-meter radius of the site. Please note that this Waste Disposal Site Letter does not quantify the chemical or physical quality of the site.

This letter was requested by the City of Windsor to the client, CK Mechanical Heating & Cooling Inc., to determine risk associated with intended future developments at the site in relation to Waste Disposal Sites within 500 meters of the site to satisfy the requirements of the "Windsor Official Plan" Volume I, Chapter 5, subsection 5.4.9.

Upon reviewing the Waste Disposal Site Inventory, SME has identified 2 active waste disposal sites and 2 closed waste disposal sites within 500 meters of the site. The following can be summarized for the sites:

Considering the geological and physical characteristics of the Windsor-Essex region, it is pertinent to note the following observations from SME:

- The region is characterized by clay-rich soils, which exhibit low permeability and can impede or slow the movement of contaminants. This reduces the risk of contaminants reaching groundwater or adjacent properties.
- Should contaminants migrate into groundwater or drainage systems, the anticipated direction of
 groundwater flow would be directed west/northwest towards the Detroit River which is situated
 700 m west/northwest of the site. As such, any contaminants which may be present at the listed
 waste disposal sites would be redirected away from the site and west towards the Detroit River
- Additionally, man-made features such as utility trenches may serve as barriers between the site
 and the waste disposal site.

Furthermore, both closed waste disposal sites were classified by the MOE as "NP" in the Waste Disposal Site Inventory indicating no potential impact to human health or the environment. Despite less stringent regulations at the time of the publication of the Waste Disposal Site Inventory, SME concludes that due to inferred direction of groundwater flow, regional geology, distance of the waste disposal property from the site and underground utilities there is low probability of adverse environmental impact to the site at 3858 - 3868 Peter Street, arising from the any of the listed waste disposal sites.



'Report Summary'- Displays a chart indicating how many records fall on the project property and, within the report search radii.


'Site Report Summary'-Project Property'- This section lists all the records which fall on the project property. For more details, see the 'Detail Report' section.


'Site Report Summary-Surrounding Properties'- This section summarizes all records on adjacent properties, listing them in order of proximity from the project property. For more details, see the 'Detail Report' section.

<u>Map Key:</u> The map key number is assigned according to closest proximity from the project property. Map Key numbers always start at #1. The project property will always have a map key of '1' if records are available. If there is a number in brackets beside the main number, this will indicate the number of records on that specific property. If there is no number in brackets, there is only one record for that property.

The symbol and colour used indicates 'elevation': the red inverted triangle will dictate 'ERIS Sites with Lower Elevation', the yellow triangle will dictate 'ERIS Sites with Higher Elevation' and the orange square will dictate 'ERIS Sites with Same Elevation.'

<u>Unplottables:</u> These are records that could not be mapped due to various reasons, including limited geographic information. These records may or may not be in your study area, and are included as reference.







CITY OF WINDSOR SEWER AND COASTAL FLOOD PROTECTION MASTER PLAN
